Glenn W. Hill, age 71, of Delaware, OH a loving husband and father, a servant of the living God, went home to be with his LORD and Savior on July 10, 2016 after a brief illness. While he will be greatly missed by his family and friends we all take comfort in knowing that we will see him again one day.

He was born October 18, 1944 to Carl and Mabel Hill in Youngsville, NC. After graduating from Youngsville High School he joined the U.S. Air Force where he met his beloved wife Jean, herself also a member of the U.S. Air Force. They relocated to Delaware, Ohio in 1978 where they raised their family. Glenn was working for the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services when the medical issues that eventually took his life struck.
